Dr. C.K. Beneragama, born in Kaluthara (Western Province, Sri Lanka) in 1971 June 23rd, received his primary education at Kaluthara Maha Vidyalaya (1978-1982) and secondary education from Nalanda College, Colombo (1983-1990), Sri Lanka.
