Guidelines

3MT competition will be **conducted according to the rules and guidelines introduced by the University of Queensland, Australia**. Following are the guidelines/ rules of the competition.

- ✤ A single static PowerPoint slide is permitted (no slide transitions, animations or 'movement' of any description, the slide is to be presented from the beginning of the oration).
- ♦ No additional electronic media (e.g. sound and video files) are permitted.
- ✤ No additional props (e.g. costumes, musical instruments, laboratory equipment) are permitted.
- Presentations are limited to 3 minutes maximum and competitors exceeding 3 minutes are disqualified.
- Presentations are to be spoken word (e.g. no poems, raps or songs).
- Presentations are to commence through online.
- ✤ The winner will be presenting at the conference held.
- Presentations are considered to have commenced when a presenter starts their presentation through movement or speech.
- ✤ The decision of the panel of judges will be the final.
- The video recording should be uploaded to the website along with the slide by renaming with name with initials and NIC number

Awards

A cash prize will be awarded for the first place. Certificates and gifts for 1st and 2nd runner ups and certificates of participation will be awarded for the top10 places.
